GPS testing is scheduled as follows and may result in unreliable or unavailable GPS signal.

- A. Location: Centered at 645447N1464448W or the FAI VORTAC 060-degree radial at 33NM.
- B. Dates and times:

12 – 17 NOV 17 0600Z – 1600Z
- C. Duration: Each event may last the entire requested period.
- D. NOTAM INFO: NAV GPS (JFAK GPS 17-03) (INCLUDING WAAS, GBAS, AND ADS-B) MAY NOT BE AVBL WI A 519NM RADIUS CENTERED AT 645447N1464448W (FAI 060033) FL400-UNL, 468NM RADIUS AT FL250, 389NM RADIUS AT 10000FT, 384NM RADIUS AT 4000FT AGL, 336NM RADIUS AT 50FT AGL.
- E. Pilots are encouraged to report anomalies only when ATC assistance is required.

The NOTAMs discussed in this advisory may change with little or no notice. Pilots are advised to check NOTAMs frequently for possible changes prior to operations in the area. NOTAMs will be published at least 24 hours in advance of any GPS tests.
