The NANWAK Nondirectional Beacon and Direction Measure Equipment, (AIX NDB/DME) has been out of service for several years. Unfortunately, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) no longer has a sustainment program for NDBs beyond routine maintenance and operation. The FAA therefore seeks to decommission AIX NDB/DME

Decommissioning AIX NDB/DME will cause the cancellation of the Mekoryuk Airport NDB-B and NDB/DME-A instrument approaches.

Airways V319 and R50 impacts and mitigations are yet to be determined and will be addressed in a separate rule-making action.
