**PROPOSED DECOMMISSIONING
Soldotna Nondirectional Beacon
Soldotna, Alaska**

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is conducting an aeronautical study of a proposal to decommission Soldotna Nondirectional Beacon (NDB) (OLT), Soldotna, Alaska.

OLT is being considered for decommissioning to avoid rising operating costs and increasing difficulties in maintaining the equipment. OLT is not used to identify airways but does support two NDB instrument approach procedures into the Soldotna Airport. Decommissioning OLT will cause cancellation of the Soldotna Airport NDB Runway 07 and NDB Runway 25 instrument approach procedures. All other approach procedures will remain unchanged.

OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT: Interested parties are invited to respond by submitting written data, views, and/or arguments related to the overall aeronautical, economic, environmental, and/or energy aspects of the proposal. All communications received on or before the specified comment closing date will be considered.
